


STRONG INDUSTRIES ON A GROWTH CURVE


No wonder manufacturers and industries of the future grow so successfully here with us.


GREAT PREREQUISITES FOR THE AUTOMOTIVE INDUSTRY

With annual sales of 15.5 billion euros and over 47,500 employees, the automotive industry is among the most important industries in Saarland.

Ford produces its most successful model, the Focus - and its electric version, the Focus Electric - in Saarland.

For OEMs and suppliers, Saarland provides excellent export conditions. This is proven by the economic data of the industry. 6 billion euros were generated by the export business.

On average, the industry invests 350 million euros in Saarland annually.




INTERNATIONAL CORPORATIONS AT THE LOCATION

„JUST IN SEQUENCE“: FORD INDUSTRIAL SUPPLIER PARK



Ford Industrial Supplier Park:

- Total floor area 100,000 m²
- Suppliers, logisticians and service providers
- Step into the production process of the car plant ‘just in time’ and ‘just in sequence’.
- Two overhead tracks (conveyor belts), 1,000 m and 300 m in length.
- The production location in Saarland is one of the most successful in the global Ford network and has set benchmarks worldwide.

SBB Saarland Bau und Boden Projektgesellschaft mbH runs the Supplier Park, which was designed and raised for FORD by SBB in the late 1990s



SUCCESS STORY FORD

Key Facts Ford Saarlouis:

- Lead plant for the Ford Focus family
- JIT production of excellence within the Ford Industrial Supplier Park
- Three-shift operation with adjacent industrial park since 1998
- Over 14 million vehicles produced up to now
- More than 80% export
- The Saarlouis plant is the first industrial firm which meets the requirements of European eco-audit-system in 1996
- Since launch of the plant, there have been about 25,000 new employment opportunities in trade, industrial and supplier sectors





Producing cars in Saarland for over four decades, Ford has become an engine of the Saarland economy. Together with the affiliated industrial park, the lead plant for the Ford Focus and C-MAX forms the biggest industrial complex in Saarland. One factor of success are our highly motivated and well-trained employees, among them a high percentage of skilled workers. In fall 2014, the Saarlouis Ford plant started the serial production of the new Focus. All in all, Ford has invested roughly 200 millions of euros for the launch of production of the new model in Saarlouis. This is a strong commitment to our Saarland factory.
